1 Summary of Discussions

A gamma-ray spectrometer based on 15 EU-ROBALL Cluster Ge detectors is planned to be installed at the F11 focus of the BigRIPS spectrometer. The spectrometer will have a photopeak efficiency of 15 % at 662 keV and therefore greatly enhances the RIBF's physics program for isomer and beta-delayed gamma-ray spectroscopy of exotic nuclei.

This workshop was the kickoff meeting for tion that needs further discuss this European RIKEN Cluster Array (EURICA) ple, the intended data acquisit and analysis software for EURICA on the physics case for EURICA were given that showed great interest in using the RIBF's un-

matched exotic beam yields in particular from induced fission reactions. From the discussed physics case a set of proposals is intended to be submitted for the 10th RIBF NP-PAC meeting at the end of 2011.

Several technical aspects for the construction phase, the foreseen time-line and the organizational structure were discussed. One open question that needs further discussion is, for example, the intended data acquisition (DAQ) system and analysis software for EURICA. Thus, follow up meetings between the collaborators in charge for the DAQ of the different detection systems of EURICA have been suggested.
