1. Subjects to be discussed

Construction of Rare-RI Ring, which is one of basic big experimental-apparatus in RIKEN RI Beam Factory (RIBF), will start soon. The main purpose of the Rare-RI Ring is to measure mass of unstable nuclei

related to R-process, which are located very far from the stability. The Rare-RI Ring can also be used for life-time measurements of unstable nuclei, reaction studies for unstable nuclei with internal targets and so on. In this symposium, technical issues related to Rare-RI Ring and possible physics programs in Rare-RI Ring will be discussed. This symposium also provides good occasions to meet researchers related to storage ring and mass measurements for unstable nuclei around the world.

This symposium will be done as one of satellite workshops prior to OMEG11 (http://indico.cns.s.u-tokyo.ac.jp/conferenceDisplay.py?confId=43). Participants for OMEG11, who are specially interested in mass measurements and physics of storage ring, are welcome to participate this symposium.
